

The Boat Inn is committed to protecting your privacy. We will only use the information that we collect about you lawfully (in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 and the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003 and 2018 GDPR.

1. What information do we collect?

We may collect the following information:

- Name
- Contact information including email address
- Other information relevant to customer offers

When you visit our Website (including the mobile optimised version of the Website accessible from your portable hand-held device) you may provide us with personal information such as name, telephone number and email address. You may provide us with Information in a number of ways:

(a) by supplying us with the information as listed above, on the Contact Us online form, in which case we may retain the content of your email messages together with your email address and our responses in a secure area

(b) by signing up to our newsletter, in which case all data is held in a secure third party platform

(c) by booking online where your data will be held by a third party. Your data will be used to process and reserve your booking

(d) by making an event enquiry. Your data will be securely stored if your enquiry is successful and an event is organised, and used in organising your event. You should let us know if you would like this data to be deleted once your event has been held. For enquiries where the events does not happen or is cancelled, your information will be deleted

(e) By applying for a job. The data or CV you supply will be stored safely and will not be used for any marketing purposes or shared with any third parties without your permission. Your data or CV will be deleted once the recruitment process for your application is completed.

Payment Card Information

To use certain services on our Sites and Applications we may require credit or debit card account information in order to:

- make reservations at certain restaurants
- make payments to certain restaurants
- pay a deposit to certain restaurants

pre-order at certain restaurants and to purchase gift vouchers.

By submitting your credit or debit card account information through our Sites, to the extent permitted by applicable law, you expressly consent to the sharing of your information with restaurants, third-party payment processors (e.g Stripe), and other third-party service providers, and you further agree to the following terms.

When you use a credit or debit card to secure a reservation through our Sites, we provide your credit or debit card account information (including card number and expiration date, but excluding the CVV number) to our third-party payment service providers and the applicable restaurant.

When you initially provide your credit or debit card account information through our Sites in order to use our restaurant payment services, we provide your credit or debit card account information to our third-party payment service providers. As explained in the ResDiary Terms and Conditions, these third parties may store your credit or debit card account information so you can use our restaurant payment services through our Sites in the future to the extent permitted by local law.

2. How we use the information

We will not disclose your information to any third parties. Our internal procedures cover the storage, access and disclosure of your information. 3. Where we store the information

Storage of data is password protected and securely kept in top tier third party platform. The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the European Economic Area ("EEA"). It may also be processed by staff operating outside the EEA who work for us or for one of our suppliers. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.

All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers. Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

8. Cookies

We may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file, which is stored on your browser or the hard drive of your computer. All data collected is completely anonymous, it does not identify you as an individual in any way.

10. Content Managed System

The Content Management System (CMS) that runs this Website is Wix and it is fully secure. It uses a cookie when logging in and out and is essential for proper Website operation. It is only set if you are a registered user, so for most people it is not set at all. User data is all anonymous.

Sharing tools in the form of Facebook and Twitter share on this site, and these third party Websites may set a cookie if you are logged in to their service. Please refer to the Facebook and Twitter cookie policies.

You block cookies by activating the setting on your browser which allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies.
